# **Torbay Waste Management Strategy**

#### **Composting**

The Town of Torbay, in partnership with the Towns of Flatrock, Pouch Cove, Logy Bay-Middle Cove-Outer Cove and Bauline has ordered compost bins from the Multi-Materials Stewardship Board. This year, the Town will be offering two options: bins and tumblers. The Town will provide a further update when the bins and tumblers are available for purchase.

## **Curbside Pick Up**

Appointment Based Starting on May 28th and ending on June 27th, the Public Works Department will take appointments for bulk garbage pick-up for those with limited means. This will run for a period of 5 weeks. Appointments must be made on the Tuesday of each week. Pick up will occur on the Thursday of each week. One pick up per household. A \$25.00 fee will apply and must be paid in advance. Residents will be required to bring the bulk garbage to the end of their driveway and have items clearly separated (metals, garbage and grass clippings/leaves). Please call the Town Hall at 437-6532, extension 221 to make your appointment.

# **Tree Mulching**

Trees will be accepted as part of the bulk garbage drop off at the municipal depot and will be mulched. Mulch will be available for public pick up at a later date.

## **Brown Bag Drop Off**

Grass Clippings and leaves can be placed in brown bags and dropped off to a designated site behind the Town Hall at 1288 Torbay Road on Thursdays of each week from May 23 to August 29.

## **Community Group Fundraiser**



#### **Household Hazardous Waste**

Torbay residents can now dispose of their household hazardous waste (HHW) on a regular basis at the HHW Facility at the Robin Hood Bay Regional Waste Management Facility. Hours of operation are Wednesday and Saturday from 8:00am to 4:00pm. Please note that NO hazardous waste will be accepted at the Torbay Bulk Garbage Site.

#### **ACCEPTABLE ITEMS**

- Mattresses, Box springs, Sofas, Chairs, Furniture
- Bikes
- Televisions, Computers
- Bathroom fixtures
- Carpet tied in rolls (maximum 6 feet long)
- Tree limbs tied in bundles (maximum 6 feet long)
- Glass (securely packaged and identified)
- Other bulk items normally associated with a residential household under 50 lbs/22.5 kg

- Swing sets (disassembled), Bikes
- Clothes washers, Clothes dryers, Dehumidifiers, Dishwashers, Hot water heaters
- Stoves, Microwaves, Refrigerators, Freezers, Barbeques (no wood or fabric), Metal bathtubs
- Lawnmowers, Metal doors, Metal shower tracks (no glass)
- Metal railings (maximum 6 feet long)
- Other recyclable metals normally associated with a residential household under 50lbs/22.5 kg

#### **UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS**

- Hazardous wastes such as paints, chemicals, solvents, propane/gas/oil tanks, batteries, etc.
- Regular household garbage
- Large trees and stumps
- Farthen materials
- Construction materials
- Roof shingles

- Concrete
- Brick
- Vehicle parts
- Tires
- Liquids
- Other items not normally associated with a residential household
- Items over 50 lbs/22.5 kg
