### **Maintenance Repairpersons - Community Centre**

#### **ABOUT TORBAY**

The beautiful Town of Torbay is a vibrant community with over 7,899 residents on the Avalon Peninsula of Newfoundland and Labrador. Torbay is home to over 150 businesses, three schools, and numerous community groups. Situated right on the Atlantic Ocean, Torbay offers breathtaking views in a scenic, rural setting. Conveniently bordering the capital City of St. John's, all urban amenities, including major retail centres and an international airport, are within a few minutes' drive.

#### **THE POSITION**

The Town of Torbay is seeking the services of four maintenance repairpersons (1 lead hand full time, 1 full time and 2 part time) to work in its Recreation and Community Services Department at the new community centre building and site, located at 8 Kinsmen Place. Reporting to the Community Centre Facility Supervisor, the maintenance repairpersons will perform daily inspections of all essential equipment and systems, perform or assist with preventative maintenance work involving air handling units, heat recovery ventilators, plumbing, masonry, and carpentry. Other duties include assisting with general cleanliness of facility, and maintaining the grounds. The Lead Hand will be responsible for maintaining the water balance of the splash pad when in operation.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS**

The successful candidates must have a grade twelve graduation diploma (or equivalent), in addition to considerable experience in the general maintenance of recreation facility operations with demonstrated mechanical, plumbing, and controls experience. This experience would ideally be supplemented by the completion of a pool attendants/maintenance course, WHMIS, Confined Space Entry, Fall Protection, First Aid, Transport of Dangerous Goods, Handling of Chlorine and Chlorine Containers. The Lead Hand position will be required to hold the Class II Water Distribution System Operations Certification.

#### **RATE OF PAY**

Based on the current collective agreement. GMIII pay for the Lead Hand position, plus the additional \$1.00 per hour, and GMII pay for the maintenance repairpersons.
