ABOUT TORBAY

The beautiful Town of Torbay is a vibrant community with over 7,899 residents on the Avalon Peninsula of Newfoundland and Labrador. THE POSITION

Reporting to the Director of Recreation and Community Services, the Sports Coordinator is responsible for the development, coordination, recommendation, management, facilitation, implementation, administration and evaluation of health, wellness and sport programs, which meet the needs and expectations of residents. This will include, but is not limited to, the development of a youth summer sports camp program, acting as the liaison with community sports groups and recreation leagues, serving as the coordinator and liaison for the Killick Coast Regional Games and development of health, sport and wellness initiatives, year round, for all residents. They will also build and maintain effective working relationships with related community volunteers, schools, organizations and sponsors. Evening and weekend work will be required.

This is a full time permanent position.

QUALIFICATIONS

The ideal candidate will have post-secondary education in the field of recreation, special event management or related field; a background in Community Recreation; two or more years' experience in the development and delivery of effective community sport programs and events; or any equivalent combination of experience and training acceptable to the Town. Other competencies include experience with engaging volunteers, demonstrated proficiency in computer; effective public speaking, interpersonal, writing and organizational skills.
